

TOTAL NUMBER OF DRUG-INVOLVED DEATHS JANUARY-JUNE OF 2023 VS 2022

1,015 people lost their lives due to a drug overdose in MO in the *first six months* of 2023 according to initial data.

This is a slight decrease (6%) compared to the *first six months* of 2022.

So far, all 7 regions had <u>slight decreases</u> in the total number of overdose deaths in the first six months of 2023 compared to the first six months of 2022.

About **70%** of drug overdose deaths included




About **45%** of drug overdose deaths included stimulants (like methamphetamines)
